1:45pm	Chamber Orchestra and OYO move to reserved seats in Petree
2:00pm	Concert begins – Concert order is Philharmonia, Chamber Orchestra, and then OYO

We ask that all students, when not on stage, remain in the audience for the duration of the concert, pending seating availability.

Concert Dress info for string groups

Ladies: A white blouse with sleeves and black slacks or skirt. Ladies may also elect to wear a black dress with sleeves. All skirts should be of at least knee-length when seated. Please also wear black dress shoes.

Gentlemen: Black slacks and white dress shirt along with black dress shoes and black socks.

Concert Dress for full ensembles (OYP, OYW, & OYO)

Ladies: Black blouse with sleeves and black slacks or skirt, or a black dress with sleeves. All skirts and dresses should be of knee-length or longer, and all necklines should be conservative. Ladies should also wear black dress shoes.

Gentlemen: Tuxedo, tuxedo shirt, bow tie, black socks, black dress shoes.
